| Andy’s Army Scholarship, in honor of the Rocky Mountain Regional VA Medical Center Nursing Staff | \$1,000                   | Provides scholarship support for a graduating senior attending a high school within Cambria or Somerset County who has been accepted to a post-secondary education institution to study nursing.   |
| Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship   | \$500                     | This scholarship supports one senior student annually who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team. Applicants must also plan to be enrolled in college or trade school for the upcoming academic year and have minimum GPA of 3.0 (B).  |
| Brian Wincer Goals 4 Education Scholarship   | \$500                     | Open to any student attending a school in Cambria or Somerset County. Eligible students should have a history of participation in high school athletics, studied a foreign language, and displayed leadership through a class or club officer position.  |
| Cambria County HWC Scholarship   | \$1,000                   | Are you a person who loves to help people? If so, this is the right scholarship for you.<br><br>The Cambria County HWC Scholarship provides scholarship support for an individual residing in Cambria County who has been accepted to attend a post-secondary institution in Cambria County with the goal of receiving a certificate, associate’s degree, or bachelor’s degree and plans to enter into a human service field after graduation. This is open to both high school seniors and non-traditional students. Eligible schools are: Greater Johnstown Career and Technology Center, Mount Aloysius College, Penn Highlands Community College, St. Francis University, and University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown. |
| Children are Precious Fund - Johnstown Walk of Hope Scholarship                                  | Fund rep decides annually | Provides scholarships for students who have a cancer diagnosis or are a cancer survivor or who have been impacted by a cancer diagnosis of a parent or caregiver.  |

| Conemaugh Valley Culinary Association Robert Forquer Memorial Scholarship | \$500   | This scholarship was created to award students from Cambria County who have exceptional promise, financial need, and are planning to study culinary arts at an accredited post-secondary school.  |
| Dr. Brad Puckey Memorial Scholarship                                      | \$500   | Provides scholarship support for students who have graduated from a high school in Cambria or Somerset counties, have military experience, and are pursuing post-secondary education in an economics or business major  |
| Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship                                       | \$1,000   | Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.  |
| Jim Janak Memorial Student Athlete Award                                  | \$500   | This fund was created in memory of Jim Janak, who excelled in sports. His award recognizes outstanding school athletes from Cambria County and supports their academic pursuits. Eligible applicants must have lettered in two high school sports, display a strong work ethic on and off the field, demonstrate teamwork, loyalty, and selflessness when dealing with others, and have a GPA of 3.2 or higher.   |
| Larry R. Mastrine Memorial Scholarship                                    | Maximum award amount of \$30,000 to be paid out over four years | <p>Dr. Larry Mastrine was a competent, dedicated, and well-loved physician in his community for over 40 years. He believed in the value of education and hard work, and he treated his patients and everyone he knew with kindness. Dr. Mastrine grew up in the small town of Colver, studied in Pittsburgh, and returned to raise his family in the community that was a source of pride for him. His patients became friends and he worked tirelessly to solve their medical issues and to encourage them during illness and tough times. Sadly, Dr. Mastrine passed away in January 2021. The Mastrine family, inspired by Dr. Mastrine's commitment to and impact on his community, has established a scholarship fund in Dr. Mastrine's memory that will allow local college eligible young adults with financial constraints an opportunity to complete college and begin satisfying careers.</p> <p>This Larry R. Mastrine Memorial Scholarship is available to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• High school juniors and seniors, as well as freshmen community college students</li> <li>• Who have attended or are attending a high school in Cambria County or Windber High School</li> <li>• Who are pursuing or plan to pursue a 4-year degree</li> <li>• Who have financial need</li> </ul> <p>Award amounts will vary based on the financial need of the student with a maximum amount of \$30,000 paid out up to four years, so long as the student is making satisfactory progress towards graduation.</p> |

| Mary Ann McCabe Memorial Scholarship                | \$600               | This scholarship aims to award Cambria County students who will be pursuing post-secondary education, have a minimum 3.0 GPA, and who is a majorette.  |
| McCready Family Scholarship                         | \$2,600             | Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset, or Bedford County who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown.   |
| Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship                   | \$500               | Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.  |
| Paul D. Bennett And Doris Haselrig Scholarship      | \$500               | This award provides a scholarship annually to a minority student. In selecting a recipient of the scholarship, the following shall be considered: a minority student attending a four year college, and the student must be a resident of Cambria County, PA.  |
| Robert B. and Frances C. Hornick Family Scholarship | \$500               | Provides a scholarship to a senior from a school in the Greater Johnstown area who intends to pursue a bachelor's degree at any campus of the University of Pittsburgh in the fall after graduation. Financial need and proof of acceptance by a campus of the University of Pittsburgh are required. Eligible schools are Bishop McCort, Conemaugh Valley, Ferndale, Greater Johnstown, Richland, and Westmont.   |
| Side by Side Humanitarian Award                     | Two at \$5,000 each | <p>The Side by Side Humanitarian Award, provided through the LivRed Foundation, was established to recognize outstanding individuals who dedicate their time to fighting indifference, intolerance, and injustice. Ideal applicants must meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Graduating Senior from a Cambria County school</li> <li>• Attending any post-secondary school</li> <li>• Must be a volunteer or employed person, who goes above and beyond their duties to improve the lives of others, and serve the community as a model or mentor</li> <li>• Fundraiser or charitable contributor that supports youth/senior programs, animal interests, or other local nonprofit organization</li> <li>• Demonstrates random acts of kindness</li> </ul> <p>This award is given in memory of Olivia Catherine Red. Olivia walked into a room and the light came on. Her glow put the sun to shame. She was the first one to pick you up and make you smile when you were down. She was a champion of the underdog, she was good to people, funny, loyal, and more than anything she was kind. The recipient of the Side by Side Humanitarian Award is that special person who wakes up every morning and puts others before themselves, and dedicates their life to helping others in need.</p> |

| <p>Sgt. 1<sup>st</sup> Class Raymond Richard Buchan Memorial Scholarship</p> | <p>The number of scholarships and amounts will vary but multiple scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500 are often awarded.</p> | <p>Students are eligible to be considered if they:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have a parent, sibling, or grandparent who has honorably served or is currently serving in any branch of the Armed Forces or he/she has signed a written obligation to serve in any branch of the military.</li> <li>• Candidates will be judged on extracurricular school activities, community service, citizenship, participation in leadership programs such as Outdoor Odyssey, employment history, and a mandatory essay.</li> <li>• Must provide proof that parent, sibling, or grandparent has honorably served or is currently serving. If you are joining the military, please provide documentation of your written service obligation.</li> </ul> |
| <p>Walter F. Mitchell, Sr. Memorial Scholarship</p>                          | <p>\$700</p>   | <p>The recipient shall be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electrical engineering major preferred (If there are no electrical engineering applicants, the award will be based on financial need)</li> <li>• Must attend 4-year accredited school</li> <li>• Grade point average of 3.0 or better (based on 4.0 system)</li> <li>• Participation in extracurricular and community activities</li> </ul> <p>Financial need will be taken into consideration</p>  |
| <p>Wilfred Jr. and Karen (Carter) Brandon Scholarship</p>                    | <p>\$2,000</p>   | <p>To provide a deserving, African-American male or female student with financial support during their first and second years of college. This award will honor students who excel in the classroom, model admirable leadership, and serve their community. Eligible schools include Bishop McCort, Conemaugh Valley, Ferndale Area, Forest Hills, Greater Johnstown, Richland, and Westmont Hilltop.</p>   |
| <p>YWCA Karen Kleinosky Scholarship</p>                                      | <p>2 at \$500 each</p>   | <p>Provides scholarship support for female students who have attended a high school located in Cambria or Somerset counties.</p>  |

| Coach Larry Layton Memorial Scholarship              | \$500         | Provides a scholarship for a graduating senior at Richland School District who is a member of the track team and also a well-rounded student, not necessarily the highest performing, but motivated and active in extracurriculars.   |
| Dorothy Pekala Scholarship                           | \$1,400       | Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior from Richland High School who has been accepted to, and will be attending, St. Francis University in Loretto, Pennsylvania. This is a delayed scholarship, to be paid after the student’s first year of college has been completed.   |
| Dr. Clyde E. Harriger Scholarship                    | \$1,000       | The following will be considered by the review committee:<br>- Strong academic aptitude in the collective sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Math and Physics)<br>- Matriculated at a college or university with an intended area of major in the sciences with a career goal of health sciences<br>- Demonstrate strong qualities of compassion and integrity<br>- Will consider financial need in the case of multiple qualifying students<br>- Review Committee to consist of at least the head or chair of the science department and the guidance counselor |
| Frederick K. Metzler Business Technology Scholarship | \$950         | This scholarship shall be awarded to a deserving senior from RHS in pursuit of a business technology (or like) degree of learning.  |
| Interim Hospice and Pallative Care Scholarship       | TBD           | If donation is again received by Interim Health Care, CFA will process scholarship payments. Selection is made by the school district.  |
| Jacqueline A. Huff-McCann Memorial Scholarship       | \$1,000       | Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior at Richland High School who is planning to attend the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown and major in accounting.  |

She was an Honor Roll student who was Treasurer of SADD and the Spanish Club. She danced for 13 years, played viola, piano, and was involved in musicals and the church choir which showed her passion for music. She had a strong belief in God and Christ. This scholarship allows Kiersten to be honored and remembered. |
