Award Name	Amount	Description
Andy’s Army Scholarship, in honor of the Rocky Mountain Regional VA Medical Center Nursing Staff	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for a graduating senior student attending a high school within Cambria or Somerset County who has been accepted to a post-secondary educational institution to study nursing.
Brian Wincer Goals 4 Education Scholarship	\$500	Open to any student attending a school in Cambria or Somerset county. Eligible applicants should have a history of participation in high school athletics, studied a foreign language, and displayed leadership through a class or club officer position.
Children are Precious - Johnstown Walk of Hope Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	Provides scholarships for students who have a cancer diagnosis or are a cancer survivor or who have been impacted by a cancer diagnosis of a parent or caregiver.
Doyle E. Paul Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Created in memory of Doyle Paul, who was devoted to promoting the agriculture Industry in Somerset County and on a state and national level. Eligible applicants must be graduating from a school district located in Somerset County and be a member of the Pennsylvania FFA Association. They also must be planning to pursue post-secondary education or training directly related to the practice of agriculture or agribusiness at an accredited post-secondary college, university or technical school in the upcoming fall semester. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner’s first year of college.
Dr. Brad Puckey Memorial Scholarship	\$500	Provides scholarship support for students who have graduated from a high school in Cambria or Somerset counties, have military experience, and area pursuing post-secondary education in an economics or business major.
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.
Herald and Jane (Rummel) Griffith Memorial Maple Spring College Scholarship	\$1,000	This scholarship provides a \$1,000.00 award for a qualified candidate who must be either a member of the active congregation at Maple Spring Church, or the children, grandchildren, and other family members of the congregation, as screened and qualified by the church finance committee. Eligible students will be graduating from high school this academic year and planning to attend a post-secondary institution after graduation.



J.L. Martin Scholarship	\$8,000	This scholarship was created to award outstanding students who are in need of financial assistance in order to obtain higher education and who will likely succeed in their schooling and make good future citizens. Students may be attending a college, university, or trade/technical school, and the scholarship is renewable up to four years. Eligible applicants must have resided in and attended high school in Somerset County continuously over the last four years.
McCready Family Scholarship Fund	\$2,600	Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset or Bedford county who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship	\$500	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.
Pride of Somerset County Scholarship	\$1,000	Pride of Somerset County provides support for programs that work to provide resources for and education about the LGBTQ+ population within Somerset and the surrounding counties. Their scholarship awards \$1,000 to a graduating senior in Somerset County who plans to attend a post-secondary school for Gender Studies, LGBTQ affairs or practices, or Behavioral Health, and who has financial need.
Tika Hetrick, Cory Roadman, and Tucker, Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	This scholarship awards students who worked at Hickory Hollow Campground or Haunted Hollow, in memory of Tika Hetrick, Cory Roadman and Tucker, beloved members of the Hickory Hollow and Haunted Hollow team. It is available to graduating seniors and nontraditional students so long as they're pursuing post-secondary education.
William R. Lloyd, Jr. Scholarship	\$3,000	This scholarship award supports graduating seniors of Somerset County public high schools who intend to major in Government, Political Science, or Politics. The award has been endowed by former State Representative Bill Lloyd (D-Somerset) to encourage Somerset County students to pursue careers in public service. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met.
YWCA Karen Kleinosky Scholarship	2 at \$500 each	Provides scholarship support for female students who have attended a high school located in Cambria or Somerset counties.

Award Name	Amount	Description
Dr. Rosemarie Tipton Scholarship	\$500	Created to support a graduating senior of the Shanksville-Stonycreek School District who shows perseverance and dedication, exhibits a strong work ethic, challenges their limits to perform beyond their abilities and lift their skills to new levels and demonstrates good moral character. The student must be accepted at an accredited post-secondary school. Winner selected by committee of district teachers – six current and one retired.
Jonathan W. Shirley, Jr. Scholarship	\$1,000 each	Created to provide scholarship support for two graduating seniors of the Shanksville-Stonycreek School District who demonstrate hard work, perseverance and the desire to achieve. The two (2) \$ 1,000.00 scholarships may be applied to study at a two or four-year accredited technical school or college, however, the students must demonstrate financial need. Winner selected by school district committee.
Viking Pride Award	\$200 (if district provides funding to make award available)	Supports a graduating senior student of the Shanksville-Stonycreek School District who exhibits the personal attributes of leadership, responsibility and community service as demonstrated in the school and the community.

Camp PARC Helping Hand Scholarship	\$1,000	Applicants must have served as a Junior Counselor, Peer Buddy, Childcare Counselor, Resident Staff Assistant, or a combination of those positions for a minimum of two years for the full duration of any of the camping sessions at Camp PARC in addition to or including the summer in which they apply for the scholarship. This is an online application and will be available at cfalleghenies.org/scholarships through July 1.
George and Juanita Sanner Technical Education Award	\$1,000	Provides financial assistance to students graduating from the Somerset County Technology Center for certifications and other program expenses that are needed to pursue a career in their chosen field. Contact SCTC to apply.
