Children are Precious - Johnstown Walk of Hope Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	Provides scholarships for students who have a cancer diagnosis or are a cancer survivor or who have been impacted by a cancer diagnosis of a parent or caregiver.
Dr. Brad Puckey Memorial Scholarship	\$500	Provides scholarship support for students who have graduated from a high school in Cambria or Somerset counties, have military experience, and are pursuing post-secondary education in an economics or business major.
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.
YWCA Karen Kleinosky Scholarship	2 at \$500 each	Provides scholarship support for female students who have attended a high school located in Cambria or Somerset counties.

Matt Matusko Memorial Welding Scholarship	Two at \$750 each	This award is available to students annually enrolled in the welding program at Somerset County Technology Center.
Melanie Beckner Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for graduating senior students at Admiral Peary AVTS, Greater Johnstown Career and Technology Center, and Somerset County Technology Center who are planning to pursue post-secondary education in culinary arts or business.
George and Juanita Sanner Technical Education Award	\$1,000	This scholarship provides a \$1,000 award to an SCTC graduating senior to assist with costs incurred for industry certifications and other program expenses necessary to pursue a career in his/her chosen field. Students who have completed at least 85% of their program’s task list, have an exemplary attendance and academic record, and can demonstrate financial need will receive priority consideration.
